ASSEMBLY DISTRICT 42 WOMAN OF THE YEAR**

March 5, 2007 (Sacramento) Today, as members of the Legislature honor the outstanding contributions of women from throughout the State of California, Assemblymember Mike Feuer was pleased to name Wendy-Sue Rosen to represent Assembly District 42.

Ms. Rosen's accomplishments are many and varied, and include serving as Chairwoman of the Brentwood Community Council, one of the oldest, most respected, active neighborhood associations in Los Angeles.

"I am very excited that Wendy-Sue is AD 42's Woman of the Year. Her passion for civic involvement, community engagement and environmental activism represents many of the shared values of my district.
